Authority Name Change and New Labelling Format

With effect from 1st April 2012, the name of the regulator changes from the Telecommunications Authority (TA) to the Communications Authority (CA), and the name of its executive arm changes from the Office of the Telecommunications Authority (OFTA) to the Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA).

A new labelling format has also been introduced;



Format of Label:

English text in the upper portion in **Arial** font in black colour

Chinese text in the upper portion in 中黑體 in black colour

Border in black colour

Background colour in white

Format of Certificate No.:

ZZZZZ : Certification Body code assigned by OFCA

YY : Year of issue

XXXXX : Serial number of certificate issued during that calendar year

As a transitional arrangement, labels previously prescribed by the Telecommunications Authority (TA) and a Certification Body (CB) before the establishment of the Communications Authority (CA) can continue to be used for equipments previously certified.
