

# Regulatory Alert - Mexico

## Public consultation on maximum SAR limits

Mexican RF body, *Instituto Federal de Telecomunicaciones* (IFT) have released a statement on their website advising a public consultation is underway concerning the draft IFT-012-2016. The main objective of this draft is to establish technical specifications for compliance with the maximum limits, measured by the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR), of non-ionising radiation of products, equipment, devices, or apparatus for devices that can be connected to a telecommunications network and/or make use of the radio electric spectrum in the range of 30 MHz to 6 GHz.

The public consultation officially opened on 12<sup>th</sup> December and will close on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2017.
