## **Public consultation on possible allocation of 57-64GHz band for free use**

Mexican Regulator *Instituto Federal de Telecomunicaciones* (IFT) have released a statement on their website advising a public consultation is underway concerning the possible allocation of the 57-64GHz band for free use. The main objective of this public consultation is to obtain comments, opinions or suggestions from any interested parties on this frequency band.

The public consultation officially opened on 17<sup>th</sup> November and will close on 9<sup>th</sup> December. Any interested parties can submit their comments, opinions or suggestions up until this date to [planeacion.espectro@ift.org.mx](mailto:planeacion.espectro@ift.org.mx), or by sending a letter to the IFT's *Oficialía de Partes Común* department at the following address:
