

Regulatory Update – Nepal

New frequency bands are open in Nepal

On 18th July, 2016, Nepal Telecommunications Authority (NTA) and Ministry of Information & Communications (MOIC) released the regulation *Spectrum Policy Amendment 2073* whereby the following frequency bands have been opened:
